

SPECIAL CATEGORY CERTIFICATE VERIFICATION GUIDELINES

The registered candidates who applied under special categories, viz., Defence Personnel (CAP), National Cadet Corps (NCC), Physically Challenged (PwD), Games & Sports, and Scouts & Guides (SG) (AP EAPCET–2026 Ranks), for B.Sc. (Hons) Agriculture and B.Tech. (Food Technology) under the Bi.P.C. stream, are requested to attend certificate verification in person as scheduled, without fail.

National Cadet Corps

- The following clauses shall be taken into consideration in the course of NCC admissions.
- All **original certificates along with supporting camp certificates** to be produced at the time of verification **along with two sets of xerox copies**.

NOTE

- 1) Priority will be given for Certificates attained prior to appearing in the qualifying exam. Hence, NCC- B and A certificates are only eligible.
- 2) The N.C.C. Directorate, Andhra Pradesh shall be responsible to draw a merit list in respect of N.C.C. cadets seeking admission under N.C.C. quota for all the categories.
- 3) In case of tie, EAPCET merit will be the deciding factor for position in the merit list under N.C.C category.
- 4) Only N.C.C. Certificates issued by N.C.C. Authorities shall be valid.

Sports & Games

- The priorities under sports & games quota will be fixed by SAAP authorities.
- All ***original certificates*** to be produced at the time of verification **along with two sets of xerox copies.**

Guidelines			
a)	Preference shall be given to the performance and participation in individual disciplines over team disciplines within in a priority.		
b)	Date of Birth shall be tallied proportionately to the category of age group vis-à-vis the concerned sport. The date of birth certificate issued by the Board of Secondary Education/ Similar Boards of Central / State Governments only shall be entertained as proof of age;		
c)	Admission shall be given to the candidates on their current sports performance, which will be to a maximum of 3 years.		
d)	The sports qualification, acquired between the period from the 10th /Inter/Diploma/Degree Examination, as the case may be, and the respective Common Entrance Test, shall also be taken into consideration for extending sports quota to meritorious sportspersons, subject to the maximum period mentioned at provision (c) above;		
e)	Representation in the approved games and sports after qualifying at relevant Common Entrance Test shall not be considered;		
f)	In case of a tie between two or more candidates, for the sports quota reservation for the same seat, rank at "Common Entrance Test" will prevail'		
g)	No preference shall be given to the candidates having represented more than one game or sport. The priority will be decided based on the highest entitlement from among the priorities admissible to a particular candidate based on his/her representation in different games/sports;		
h)	The decision of sports Authority of Telangana/Andhra Pradesh is final and for scrutiny of claims by sports Authority of Telangana/Andhra Pradesh, the candidates shall submit information as called for in the format prescribed by sports Authority.		

Defence personal (CAP)

- All **original certificates** to be produced at the time of physical verification **along with two sets of xerox copies.**

Children of Armed Forces Personnel (CAP) Certificate issued by the Zilla Sainik Welfare Officer.

1. Discharge Book (All pages).
2. Ex-Servicemen Identity Card issued by the Zilla Sainik Welfare Officer.
3. Pension Payment Order.
4. If Serving Personnel, a Service Certificate issued by the Commanding Officer from working Unit / Regiment duly mentioning permanent home address declared by serving personnel at the time of enrolment in Armed Forces.
5. In addition to the above, to avail under Priorities other than 6 (six), the proof of related documents should be submitted accordingly.

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ORDER:

The State Chief Commissioner, the Bharat Scouts and Guides, Andhra Pradesh in his letter 5th read above have requested the Government to provide 1% reservation for Rashtrapathi Award Certificate Holders under special categories quote for admission into professional courses in recognized professional colleges and universities in Andhra Pradesh on par with the NCC Certificate holders.

2. The Government have examined the issue in consultation with the Chairman, Andhra Pradesh State Council of Higher Education in the reference 6th read above, and decided to provide 0.5% reservation (horizontal) to Rashtrapathi Award Certificate holders of Bharat Scouts and Guides and other certificate holders of Bharat Scouts and Guides for admission into professional courses in recognized professional colleges and universities in Andhra Pradesh on par with the NCC certificate holders duly following the guidelines as mentioned below:-

1. The Rashtrapathi Award Certificate shall be the Highest Certificate in the Boy-Girl Programme of Bharat Scouts and Guides;
2. The Hon'ble President of India the Chief Patron of Bharat Scouts and Guides India will affix his personal signature on the certificates issued and presents the same to the qualified Scouts and Guides at a National level program;
3. The examination for the Rashtrapathi Award Certificate shall be conducted by the National Headquarters of Bharat Scouts and Guides, New Delhi for all the eligible candidates of all the States;
4. A candidate requires to pursue a 13 year certification program before achieving the Rashtrapathi Certificate as indicated below:
 - a. Qualifies in Pravesha after completion of 10 years of age
 - b. Qualifies in Prathama Sopanam
 - c. Qualifies in Dwitiya Sopanam
 - d. Qualifies in Tritiya Sopanam
 - e. Finally qualifies in Rajya Puraskar Award Certificates

3. All the above requires to pursue certification courses, active participation and commitment to the Bharat Scouts & Guides training programme and philosophy for over 13 years, i.e., almost throughout the School and Intermediate stage of education

4. A candidate between age group of 15 – 18 years after completion of all above courses can only enter into Rashtrapathi Award Certificate programme.
